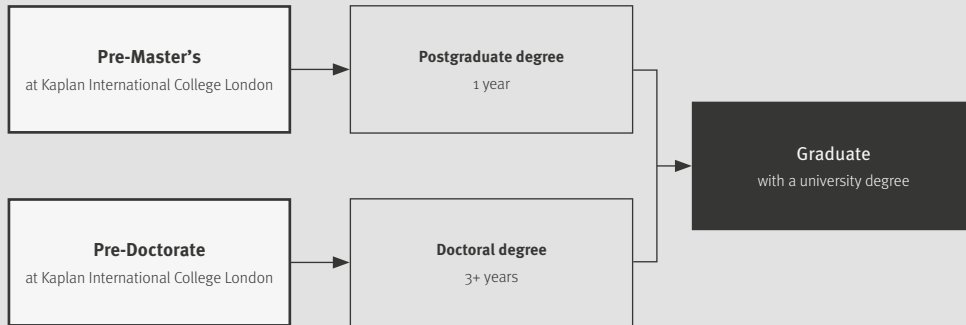

You'll develop a wide range of mathematical and analytical skills essential for postgraduate study in mathematics, engineering and related disciplines.

Advanced Social Science

Learn about the key theories in social sciences, and their relation to methodologies in the field.

Advanced Statistics

Develop a comprehensive mathematical skillset, including the analytical skills required for postgraduate study.
