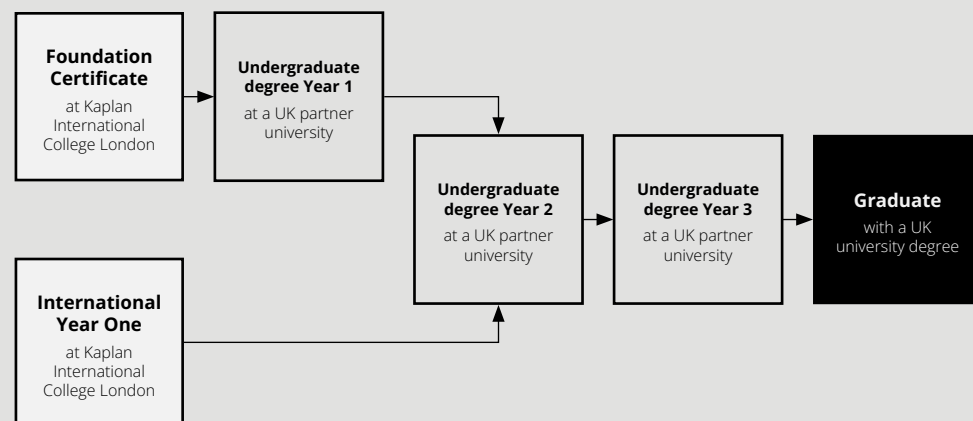
Course delivery
