Contemporary Issues in Society

Develop understanding of political and social issues, including perspectives related to education and the media.

English for Academic Purposes (0.5-term English Language Pre-Sessional)

This module aims to develop your English language ability, and will give you an introduction into academic English and the study skills that you will need to be a successful student.

English for Academic Purposes (1-term Entry to Pre-Masters)

Learn English language skills in an academic context, and improve your writing and speaking skills.

International Business with Law

Achieve a broad understanding of the international business environment, including its financial and legal aspects.

Introduction to Management

Understand the functions of management within a practical context.

Language and Study Skills

Develop academic English knowledge, and apply academic style to written and spoken work.
